LEARNING OUTCOMES

- **Use** a practical AT consideration process focused on student strengths, tasks, environments, and barriers.
- **Determine** when an AT evaluation or structured AT trial is needed and what data to collect.
- **Document** AT devices, services, accommodations, staff supports, and monitoring clearly in the IEP.
- **Match** reading and writing barriers with appropriate scaffolds, accessible materials, and AT supports.
- **Use** the ATP Education Program’s Loan Pool to explore and trial AT tools before decisions are finalized.
- **Connect** student-level AT practices to AT components within the Targeted Improvement Plan.
